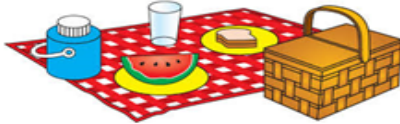
***IN MEMORIAM**—Judith Ann Koah of New Port Richey was called to the Lord on 3/15 at the age of 73.
